

We're so glad to be sharing the harvest with you. Please take a moment to read through these tips, so you can make the most of your currency this summer.

You will receive \$28 of currency per week that you can spend at a participating farmers' market.

Community food currency can be used to purchase fruit, eggs, meat, dairy, fish, nuts, vegetables, honey and cut herbs.

Vendors cannot give change for purchases made with community currency.

All currency must be used by October 22nd. Please make sure to check your farmers' market's dates as not all markets run this late in the season.



Look for this sign saying 'Accepted Here' to know which booths to shop at. **All farm booths at participating farmers' markets accept community food currency.** 

Make sure you know the day, time, and location of the participating farmers' market you will be shopping at.
